Subject: Contract / Spending Policy

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to outline the authority, the responsibility, the limits, and the guidelines for SMHC spending and executing contracts.

Scope:

This policy applies to all spending by SMHC for the purposes of carrying out the SMHC mandate.

Authority and Limits:

- 1. All work supplied by an external proponent over \$10,000 requires a written contract.
- 2. All contracts \$25,000 and over must be presented to the board for information purposes and contracts over \$75,000 require Board approval.
- 3. All contracts must be executed by the General Manager and one Executive Committee member.
- 4. Contracts over \$10,000 but under 75,000 (annual costs) require a minimum of three quotes secured as to the Tender Standard Operating Procedure
- 5. Contracts \$75,000 (annual costs) and over require a Request for Proposal process.

Payment Approvals:

- 1. SMHC payments of \$10,000.00 or over will be authorized as follows:
 - a. \$10,000.00 to \$99,999.99 by the General Manager PLUS one (1) Executive Committee Member.

- b. \$100,000.00 to \$499,999.99 by the General Manager PLUS two (2) Executive Committee Members.
- c. \$500,000.00 to \$999,999.99 by the General Manager PLUS three (3) Executive Committee Members.
- d. Greater than \$1,000,000 by the General Manager PLUS four (4) Executive Committee Members.
- 2. Select vendors may be authorized on an on-going basis for payment via automatic debit or other means. The Finance Committee will provide the Board of Directors annually a list of vendors to review and approve for this.
- 3. Any spending over the approved budgeted, contracted, or projected amount needs to be approved by the Board of Directors before being spent.
- 4. To move funds between categories of the operating budget requires the approval of the board.
